On **Thursday 23rd May 2019**, Bristol Breakfast Rotary Club will be holding its annual Charity Golf Day at the **Bristol & Clifton Golf Club**, Failand, Bristol. Proceeds from this year's Golf Day will support the work of **Bridges to Prosperity** and other Rotary charities. **Bridges to Prosperity** envisions a world where poverty caused by rural isolation no longer exists. Rural isolation is a root cause of poverty, and they believe that connection is the foundation to opportunity. They work with local communities, partners and foundations, to build footbridges that connect residents to education, health care and economic opportunity. Proceeds from this Golf Day will help to fund two pedestrian bridges in Kawuswo and Moyok in Uganda.

The **format of the day** will be as last year, with the number of teams of four players limited to **twenty-two** to minimise waiting. The cost of entering a Team is the same as last year at **£350** and will include **ALL** the following;

- Bacon bap and coffee on arrival;
- Nine hole Texas Scramble in the morning;
- Light lunch,
- Eighteen hole team Stableford competition in the afternoon; and
- Dinner, Promises Auction and the presentation of prizes, in the B&C Clubhouse,

As usual, a competition package will be available which will include Hole-in-One, Longest Drive, Nearest the Pin and Putting Competition.
